When he attacked the "separate but equal" theory his real thought behind it was that "All right, if you want it separate but equal, I will make it so expensive for it to be separate that you will have to abandon your separateness. Houston also continued to advise Thurgood Marshall who had taken over the duty the first to add this to a list.
