In licensed child care facilities, the behaviour management policy explains what staff or home providers do to create a supportive environment and encourage positive interactions among adults and children. Are you licensed, and, if so, in what discipline? A child taking medications should be monitored by a healthcare professional. A developmental and behavioral pediatrician is a pediatrician who has completed additional training in evaluating and treating developmental and behavioral problems. To assume a causal influence of responsive parenting on child outcomes would require data from experimental studies with random assignment. Nothing else should be in the crib except for the baby.

What About Alternative Treatment Options? A child who has autism can also have other conditions. The licence must be posted in the child care facility where it can be seen easily by parents and visitors.
